“Obedient Service- Noah”

When we are asked to serve God it can cause feelings of inadequacy or confusion. What we need to remember is when God calls us to something he will help us to complete it. With God, we don't have to have it all figured out in advance. In this lesson we will look at Noah and how he tackled Ark Building 101. When we put our trust in God even when we don't fully understand the assignment, the results can be amazing.

Open it: When you receive an assignment, do you typically dig right in or procrastinate? Have you been given an assignment with little or no instruction? How did that go?

Dig it: Read Genesis 6:14-22

1. What did God give Noah? (Vs. 14-16)
2. Noah was being asked to do something he had never done before. God knew he needed instructions and he supplied them. Even though scripture doesn't tell us, how do you think Noah prepared his heart to hear God's detailed directions?
3. How can we hear God's voice more clearly?
4. Read verse 22. How important do you think it is to obey God completely?
5. How can we follow Noah's example today?

Reflect on it:

1. How can you be a Noah today? Is there a mission you sense God is calling you to pursue?
2. What are some of the obstacles you will need to overcome to start your mission God is calling you to do?
3. What specific abilities have you been given that God maybe trying to use?

Do it:

1. Pray as a group that all in your group will find a mission that will help others.
2. Pray as a group that members of Heartlands will find their mission in our upcoming series, "Living Beyond Myself."
